COACH CODE OF CONDUCT

Player Development

A MCJFC coach, will prioritise the development of each player's skills and understanding of the game, regardless of their level ability.

Role Model

A MCJFC JFC coach will demonstrate integrity, display passion, dedication and be energised. Promote teamwork and leadership, be inclusive and respect diversity of all players and parents.

Safety & Wellbeing

The safety and well-being of players is the coach's top priority. All training sessions and matches are conducted in a safe environment.

Respect

A MCJFC JFC coach will treat all players, parents, officials and other coaches with respect and dignity, regardless of their background or opinions. I will refrain from engaging in verbal or physical abuse, harassment or discrimination or any kind.
