### **PARENTS AND SPECTATORS CODE OF CONDUCT**

**This Code of Conduct applies to all Parents/Guardians/Spectators of registered Auskick/Junior/Youth playing participants**

I/We agree to –

- Encourage children to participate, according to their interest and ability.
- Encourage children to participate according to the rules of the Club and the game.
- Use positive reinforcement when communicating with your child/ren or other players.
- Remember that children learn best from example. Applaud good plays by all teams.
- If I/We disagree with an official, I/We will raise the issue through the appropriate channels rather than questioning the official's judgment in public.
- Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from sporting activities.
- Recognise the value and importance of volunteer coaches and associated team officials.
- Remember that children play organised sports for fun. They are not playing for the entertainment of spectators only, nor are they miniature professionals.
- Condemn the use of violence in any form, be it by spectators, coaches, officials or players.
- Encourage players to follow the rules and the umpire's decisions.
- Demonstrate appropriate social behaviour by not using foul language or harassing players, coaches or officials.
- Abide by all club policies, including but not limited to those relating to alcohol, smoking, drugs and social media.
