PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT

This Code of Conduct applies to all registered Playing Participants.

By registering to play for the Mundijong Centrals Junior Football Club all players agree to the following:

- Play by the rules (of both the laws of the game and the rules of the club).
- Never argue with an official. If you disagree, you will discuss the matter with your coach or official after the game.
- Control your temper. You need to understand that verbal abuse of officials or other players, or provoking an opponent is not acceptable and will result in possible sanctions as per the club prescribed penalties policy.
- You agree to work equally hard for yourself and for your team. Your team's performance will benefit so will you.
- Be a good sport. Applaud all good plays whether they are by your team, or an opponent from the other team.
- Treat all players as you would like to be treated. Do not interfere with, bully or take unfair advantage of another player or teammate.
- Cooperate with your coach, teammates and opponents. Without them there would no competition.
- Play for the "fun of it" and not just to win or to please parents and coaches.
- Avoid using derogatory language.
- To support the team and your own personal development, players are expected to attend all training sessions, notifying the coach or team manager if you cannot attend.
